Oviedo, FL – Black Sky Training announced today that they will begin offering a specialized series of courses for General Aviation pilots. This series is intended to fill the need for ongoing training as outlined by the FAA and NTSB at this year's AirVenture at Oshkosh, Wis.

Psychological Training, recognizing and reacting to Hypoxia, will be given in one of the only privately owned and operated Hypobaric chambers in the U.S. Under an exclusive deal with the Southern AeroMedical Institute, Black Sky Training will offer courses under the direction of a Board Certified Doctor and a written by a Master CFI. This chamber and training allows a pilot to experience ALL of the symptoms of Hypoxia, proving a life saving lesson that is missed during standard low O2 training.

Until now, this training was available only through commercial flight schools or through Black Sky Training's Suborbital Pilot training program. David Allen spokesman for Black Sky and SAMI stated "Hypoxia is one of, if not the leading cause of pilot error during approach and landing. With insurance claims rising, the need for highly technical training to recognize individual symptoms is the best way to increase the likelihood of safe flights for our general aviation pilots and families."

Black Sky will begin classes at the end of August.
